Suggested Kit List

Tent and Camping Essentials Checklist

- Tent and required components (tent footprint, porch etc.)
- Spare tent pegs
- Mallets
- Sleeping bag/Duvet for each camper
- Sleeping pad or mat for each camper if tent camping
- Pillows

- Extra blankets (it gets chilly at night, even if the weather is good)
- Camping chair
- Camping table
- Toilet roll
- Torches/lanterns
- Bucket

Clothing Essentials Checklist

- Pyjamas and plenty of extra warm layers
- Socks
- Underwear
- T-shirts
- Long-sleeved T-shirts
- Trousers
- Jumpers and warm layers
- Waterproof jacket/ trousers
- Sun hat
- Sturdy flat shoes (boots, trainers or pumps)
- Wellies (fingers crossed we won't need those)

Pottery Tools & Equipment Checklist

- Pots (20-30 small to medium pieces) NOTE: See the Potter's Camp information
 sheet for the clay body requirements at camp.
- Apron/ overall
- Tool kit if you wish to use the throwing and hand-building areas
- Tongs (glazing)
- Sponges (wiping back glazes), brushes, towel

- Notepad, pen
- Long-sleeved clothes (kiln stoking)
- Fireproof gloves (kiln work)

Miscellaneous Checklist

- Breakfast and lunch meals for each day
- Ice Packs
- Sealable plastic containers, water bottle, plate, mug, knife, fork, spoon
- Sun cream
- Insect repellent
- First Aid Kit
- Any regular medication
- Anti-bacterial hand wash and sanitiser
- Dustpan and brush
- Bin bags
- Duct tape/Rope
- Batteries
- Pegs
- Head torch

Personal Items Checklist

- Towel
- Brush/comb
- Soap/shower gel/Shampoo & conditioner
- Contact lenses/glasses
- Toothbrush & toothpaste
